

Website Privacy and Cookie Notice

How we use your personal information

Islington Sixth Form Consortium (IC6) is the joint sixth forms of Central Foundation Boys' School, City of London Academy Highbury Grove, City of London Academy Islington, Highbury Fields School and St Aloysius' College.

This website privacy notice explains what we do with your personal information gathered through the IC6 website (www.ic6.co.uk), including how we collect, use and process your personal data.

This covers both the data you provide and the data we gather automatically through your use of the site. It also covers the use of cookies on the website. Your privacy is important to us and we are committed to protecting and safeguarding your data privacy rights.

What information is collected

We collect information through the IC6 website for two main purposes:

- To enable us to collect personal information for your application to join the Islington Sixth Form Consortium (IC6) schools, comprising of Central Foundation Boys' School, City of London Academy Highbury Grove, City of London Academy Islington and Highbury Fields School.

You have the legal right to be informed about how IC6 uses any personal information that we hold about you. To comply with this, we provide a 'privacy notice' to you where we are processing your personal data.

- To enable us to collect data showing us what pages are being looked at for website analysis and marketing, ultimately ensuring the website continues to meet students' needs. This is generally through the use of analytics tools allowing us to see which pages are viewed. In order to collect this information, the site may make use of third-party services which are linked from, embedded within, or made available via the IC6 website.

Cookie Policy

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device to help our website provide a better user experience. Cookies are stored on your individual device and you have full control over their use.

How to change your cookie settings

All modern browsers allow you to change your cookie settings. You can usually find these settings in the Options or Preferences menu of your browser. To understand these settings, the following links may be helpful, or you can use the Help option in your browser for more details.

Google Analytics

Like many websites, we use Google Analytics to collect information about visitor behaviour. We do this to help us improve our site. Google Analytics stores information about what pages you visit, how long you are on the site, how you got here and what you click on. This analytics data is not tied to personally identifiable information (e.g. your name or address) so this information cannot be used to identify who you are.

Below is a description of the Google Analytics cookies we may use on this site and what they are used for:

Name	Purpose	Expires
_utm.gif	Logs details about visitor's browser and computer	End of session
_utma	Used to distinguish users and sessions	2 years
_utmb	Used to determine new sessions/visits	30 mins
_utmc	Used to determine the duration of a visit	End of session
_utmv	Use to determine visitor behaviour during a session	End of session
_utmz	Stores the traffic source that explains how the user reached the site	6 months
_utmt	Used to throttle request rate.	10 minutes
_ga	Used to distinguish users	2 years
_gid	Used to distinguish users	24 hours
